- Please don't stick anything onto the walls
- If you play music, please be mindful of the neighbours. If we receive any complaints of loud music then we reserve the right to refuse you hire of the Lodge in the future.
- If you have a disco do <u>NOT</u> use a smoke machine, this will set off the fire alarm.

When you leave.....

- PLEASE SWITCH OFF MASTER SWITCH WHEN YOU LEAVE
- <u>Please take all your rubbish</u> away with you, we do not provide bin liners or dustbins.
- Please leave the Lodge clean and tidy, there are brushes and a mop in the store room in the main hall, <u>you will be charged</u> if any additional cleaning is needed.
- Please turn off the lights and ensure that the heaters in the Entrance Hall, Toilets and Den are switched off and the front and rear doors are locked.
- Please take all GAS CYLINDERS AND CARTRIDGES away with you.
- Should the FIRE ALARM SOUND, clear the building immediately and contact the Fire Service. If you are sure this is a false alarm the alarm may be deactivated by keying 5 to access then 1 to silence then 2 to reset. Please ensure you report this to the bookings secretary (stortonlodge@gmail.com) in case the alarm needs servicing.
